MBA award for aged persons villas

THE Australian Pensioner's League's Belgravia Street Cloverdale aged persons villas won the prestigious MBA Housing Excellence Award recently.

The "Federation" style villas were designed by the League's architects John Kannis and Associates and were built by BGC Constructions.

Architects John Kannis and Associates

were multi-award winners at the Master Builders' Association of Housing Excellents Awards held at the Hyatt Hotel recently.

They were the winner (or finalist) for the Metropolitan Region Contract Homes - Category 1 in Cloverdale; the finalist (or second) for the Metropolitan Region Contract Homes - Category 1 in Mandurah; the winner for Alterations and Additions - Category in 11 Lockridge. Also was the Mandurah Awards for Best Contract Homes also designed by John Kannis and Associates.

APL is now in the process of having plans drawn up for a further eight villas to be build next door to the existing block of villas in Belgravia Street. Plans for the development of land in Hocking, north of Perth are also being completed now and it is envisaged that building of these villas will commence in the latter part of this year.
