The South Hedland New Living Program is the largest urban renewal project ever undertaken in Western Australia. JAXON is acting as the Project Manager for land subdivisions and Construction Manager for refurbishments on behalf of the Department of Housing. The focus is to deliver urban renewal through four core disciplines - land subdivision (1200 residential lots), home refurbishments (547 houses), infrastructure upgrades and community development.

To date JAXON has delivered 250 refurbishments and 550 residential lots.
